

ACTION PLAN 2025/26

Introduction

The purpose of this document is to set out the activities and projects Lenham Parish Council will commence or complete within 2025/2026. Parish Councils are an essential part of the structure of local democracy and have a vital role in acting on behalf of the communities they represent. They:

- i. give views, on behalf of the parish, on planning applications and other proposals that affect the parish,
- ii. undertake projects and schemes that benefit residents,
- iii. work with partners to achieve benefits for the parish,
- iv. alert relevant authorities to problems that arise or work that needs to be undertaken,
- v. Engage and support the community, including parishioners, local businesses, community groups and organisations in Lenham,
- vi. help the other tiers of local government stay connected with their local communities.

Parish Councils have a wide range of powers which relate to local matters, such as maintaining, the recreation ground (William Pitt Field), play parks (Ham Lane and Cherry Close) and other open spaces (including Cherry Downs picnic site, St Mary's Churchyard and Lenham's memorial chalk cross).

They also have the power to raise money through the precept, which is the parish council's share of the council tax.

Implementation

All staff and Councillors have a responsibility to ensure the action plan is implemented within existing resources.

Monitoring

The Action Plan will be monitored by the Clerk with regular updates on progress towards the actions reported back to the Parish Council along with associated budget reporting.
